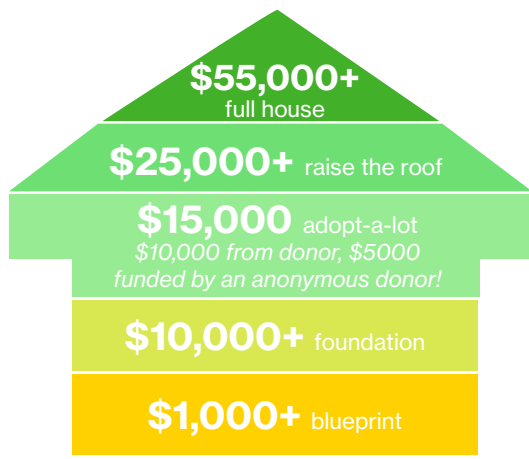
Annually, Habitat homeowners pay property taxes and invest in their communities.
