Concrete block – *all sizes*
Plywood
Shingles – *full bundles*

Nails and screws – *full boxes*
Sheet rock – *4' x 8' sheets or more*

Cabinets

Kitchen cabinets (*must have all doors and drawers*)
Countertops (*straight sections without holes only*)
Complete bathroom vanities
Vanity tops 4' or less

Doors and Windows

Double hung, picture, and bay windows
Steel, wood, and bi-fold doors
Storm doors (*must have complete frames*)

Electronics

Stereos, speakers

Flooring

Wood flooring – *20 sq ft or more*
New ceramic or vinyl tile, carpet squares – *full cases only*
New vinyl sheet goods – *5' x 8' or larger*
New carpet – *5' x 8' or larger*
Area rugs – *new or gently used*

Furniture

Upholstered furniture
Wood & metal furniture
Tables
Dressers
Bookshelves
Floor/table lamps
Ceiling fans

Hardware

Interior and exterior lock sets with keys
Working tools – *power, hand & garden*
Electrical hardware

Plumbing

Sinks – *no wall mounts*
Toilets (*1.6GPF*)
Bathtubs – *claw foot, fiberglass or solid surface*
Hot waters heaters – *less than 5 years old*
New plumbing supplies

Sporting Goods

Quality electric folding treadmills, stationary bicycles
Weight machines, iron weights
Camping equipment
Bicycles – *functional only*
General sporting goods

Miscellaneous Items

Boats, cars, RVs
Game tables
Musical instruments
